Key Considerations

- Requires SAT/GRE/GMAT (depending on program)
- English tests like IELTS/TOEFL mandatory
- F-1 Student Visa required
- Visa validity up to 5 years
- Work options: On-campus (up to 20 hrs/week, full-time in vacation)
- OPT opportunities (up to 36 months for STEM programs)

- Student Visa (Subclass 500) – Requires Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) Proof of funds & GTE/Genuine Student requirement
- Strong post-study work (PSW) opportunities
- Pathways available for PR (Permanent Residency)
